


PETROLEUM 2018



Range Resources CORP Rank 66 of 120





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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Range Resources CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Range Resources CORP compared to the market average is the variable Oil and Gas Property, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 52% points. The greatest weakness of Range Resources CORP is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 35% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 87%, being 21% points below the market average of 108%.
