The relative strengths and weaknesses of American Express Credit CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of American Express Credit CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 12% points. The greatest weakness of American Express Credit CORP is the variable Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 23% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 12%, being 5.0% points below the market average of 17%.
