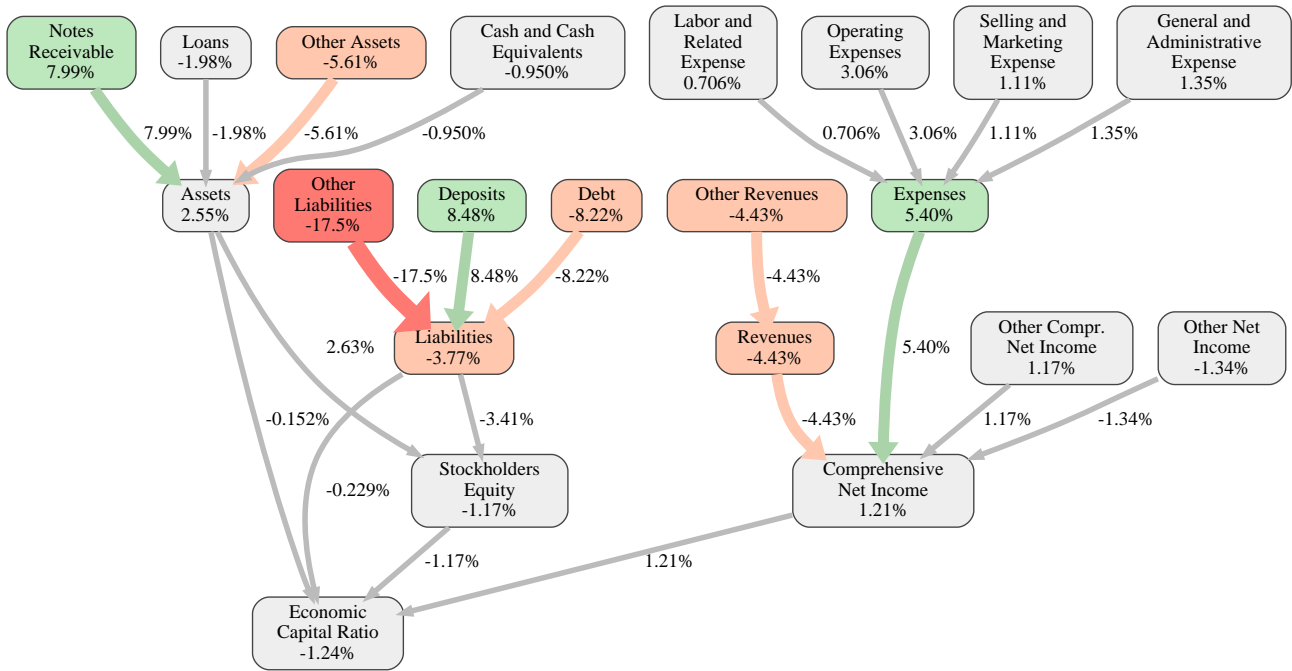

## Capitol Federal Financial Inc Rank 47 of 76



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Capitol Federal Financial Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Capitol Federal Financial Inc compared to the market average is the variable Deposits, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 8.5% points. The greatest weakness of Capitol Federal Financial Inc is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 17% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 14%, being 1.2% points below the market average of 15%.
