










SEMICONDUCTORS 2011





The relative strengths and weaknesses of Intel CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Intel CORP compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 75% points. The greatest weakness of Intel CORP is the variable Selling, General and Administrative Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 0.36% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 469%, being 131% points above the market average of 338%.
