

National Semiconductor CORP Rank 42 of 42

The relative strengths and weaknesses of National Semiconductor CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of National Semiconductor CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 29% points. The greatest weakness of National Semiconductor CORP is the variable Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 196% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 128%, being 209% points below the market average of 338%.
