

## Standard Microsystems CORP Rank 27 of 42

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Standard Microsystems CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Standard Microsystems CORP compared to the market average is the variable Selling, General and Administrative Expense, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 65% points. The greatest weakness of Standard Microsystems CORP is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 85% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 309%, being 28% points below the market average of 338%.
