

Atmel CORP Rank 20 of 42

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Atmel CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Atmel CORP compared to the market average is the variable Comprehensive Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 75% points. The greatest weakness of Atmel CORP is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 121% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 364%, being 26% points above the market average of 338%.
