

## Intel CORP Rank 16 of 107



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Intel CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Intel CORP compared to the market average is the variable Comprehensive Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 116% points. The greatest weakness of Intel CORP is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 121% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 452%, being 153% points above the market average of 299%.
