

LSI CORP Rank 68 of 108





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The relative strengths and weaknesses of LSI CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of LSI CORP compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 78% points. The greatest weakness of LSI CORP is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 139% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 198%, being 52% points below the market average of 249%.
