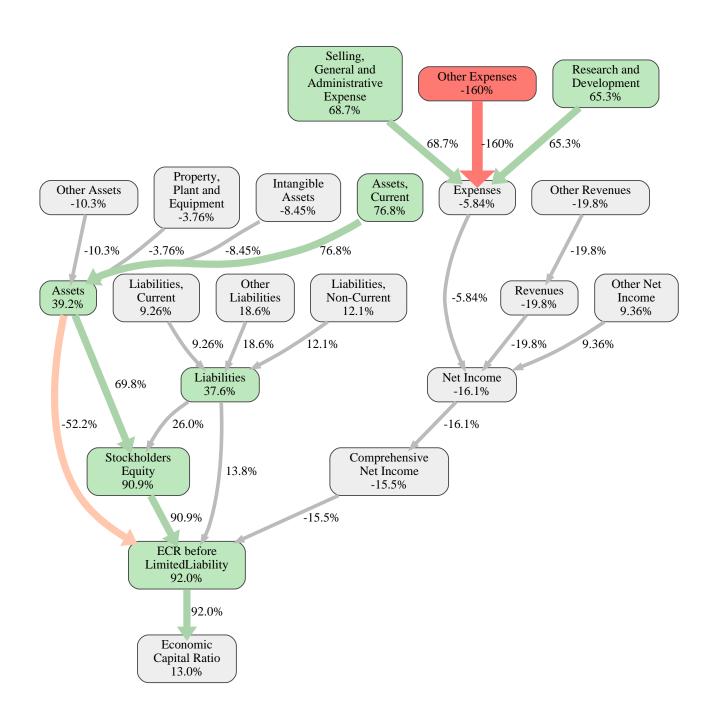

EXAR CORP Rank 54 of 108

The relative strengths and weaknesses of EXAR CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of EXAR CORP compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 91% points. The greatest weakness of EXAR CORP is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 160% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 262%, being 13% points above the market average of 249%.
