

Microsemi CORP Rank 12 of 105



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Microsemi CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Microsemi CORP compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 179% points. The greatest weakness of Microsemi CORP is the variable Amortization of Intangible Assets, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 30% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 424%, being 171% points above the market average of 253%.
