



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Monolithic Power Systems INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Monolithic Power Systems INC compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 79% points. The greatest weakness of Monolithic Power Systems INC is the variable Intangible Assets, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 9.9% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 354%, being 101% points above the market average of 253%.
