NXP Semiconductors N V Rank 35 of 44

The relative strengths and weaknesses of NXP Semiconductors N V are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of NXP Semiconductors N V compared to the market average is the variable Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 36% points. The greatest weakness of NXP Semiconductors N V is the variable Liabilities, Non-Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 106% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 185%, being 67% points below the market average of 253%.
